

NEW ADDITIONS TO THE CEMETERY

We have prepared a plat of the cemetery to confirm the names of those buried there and the locations of their graves. This plat is based upon information provided by Evans Moody in a plat dated Aug 22, 1938, which was subsequentially updated as additional graves were added. Two additional published sourc-

es were used to verify this information as follows:

- 1. *Grimes County Cemeteries–Book Two* compiled by John R. Maxwell for the Grimes County Historical Commission (www.co.grimes.tx.us) –Second Edition 2001 with input provided by Alene M. Arrington, Lorraine M. McLain, Jessica M. Brown, and Mr. and Mrs. Victor Stolz.
- 2. **Cemeteries of Texas**—Grimes County by Gloria B. Maxwell and submitted by Bill Murphy (www.cemeteries-of-tx.com). The most recent burial entry in this listing is dated 2004.

In addition to utilizing the above sources, members of the Cemetery Board performed an onsite walkthrough to verify and to add names and locations of persons buried since 2004. This plat will be very beneficial in locating loved ones buried in the cemetery and to help in confirming requests for burial locations. When the plat is finalized, it will be used to create an updated alphabetical listing of those buried in the cemetery. The information will be added to the website upon completion.

HISTORY IN THE MAKING

Ephraim Fuqua came to Texas in the early 1830s. The area he settled became known as Fuqua Prairie. In 1841, he received a land grant from the Republic of Texas, a part of which he donated for a cemetery. During the late 1890s, a post office was established on the original Fuqua land grant. Erwin Post Office was named in memory of a Fuqua child. Therefore, the cemetery and the community went by the same name. The Texas Historical Commission has designated the name of the cemetery as Fuqua Family Cemetery, although the association will continue under the name Fuqua Family Cemetery aka Erwin Cemetery Association.


WHAT DOES BECOMING A MEMBER MEAN?
